

STATISTICS ON SYSTEMATIZED SEXUAL VIOLENCE WITHIN THE U.S.

This census report was conducted on May 1, 2018 upon all of the current United States citizens over the age of 18 years old.

During the year 2012, there were 217,537 people under the age of 16 years old surviving commercialized sexual violence within the context of human trafficking (modern-day slavery) in the United States. Over \$212 million was grossed in profits from the commercialized rape of people under the age of 16 years old in the U.S. in 2012.

During the year 2017, there were 500,366 people under the age of 16 years old surviving commercialized sexual violence within the context of human trafficking (modern-day slavery) in the United States. Over \$332 million was grossed in profits from the commercialized rape of people under the age of 16 years old in the U.S. in 2017.

During the year 2017, there were 450,736 people under the age of 16 who were coerced into human trafficking for the first time in their lives. In 2017, the states with the highest numbers of people surviving human trafficking were California, Colorado, Georgia, Michigan, and New York.

The Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders (DSM-5) has defined Pedophilic Disorder (pedophilia) as recurrent, intense sexually arousing fantasies, urges or behaviors involving a prepubescent child or children that have been present for over six months. The absence of any description of becoming sexually aroused with forced intimacy leads to the common misconception that Pedophilic Disorder is a sexual orientation based on sexual desire for children.

9-10% of National Security Agency full-time employees have Sexual Sadism Disorder as defined by the diagnostic criteria of the DSM-5.

6-7% of Federal Bureau of Investigation full-time employees have Sexual Sadism Disorder as defined by the diagnostic criteria of the DSM-5.

3-4% of Central Intelligence Agency full-time employees have Sexual Sadism Disorder as defined by the diagnostic criteria of the DSM-5.

Out of all the current population of United States citizens over the age of 18 years old, between 11- 12% have Sexual Sadism Disorder as defined by the diagnostic criteria of the DSM-5, and this entire population of people has been under government surveillance their entire lives.

Out of all the current population of United States citizens over the age of 18 years old that have Sexual Sadism Disorder as defined by the diagnostic criteria of the DSM-5, about 30% of them have committed felony rape as defined by state laws, and between 23-24% of them have committed felony child sex abuse as defined by state laws, evidencing a high rate of comorbidity between Pedophilic Disorder and Sexual Sadism Disorder.

Within the population of U.S. citizens over the age of 18 years old with Sexual Sadism Disorder, 2-3% of them have been involuntarily committed into a psychiatric institution during their lives.

Within the population of U.S. citizens over the age of 18 years old with Sexual Sadism Disorder, 4-5% of them have spent more than one year in prison during their lives.

Within the population of U.S. citizens over the age of 18 years old with Sexual Sadism Disorder, 43-44% of them have spent some time in prison during their lives.

Out of all the board members and employees of non-profit organizations within the United States, 11-12% of them have Sexual Sadism Disorder as defined by the diagnostic criteria of the DSM-5.

This census report was conducted on May 2, 2018 upon all of the current United States citizens.

Out of all the current population of United States citizens over the age of 18 years old, 2-3% of them have Pedophilic Disorder as defined by the diagnostic criteria of the DSM-5.

Out of all the current population of United States citizens over the age of 18 years old, 5-6% of them have broken the law against *conspiracy* to commit any type of child sex abuse as defined by the federal laws of the U.S. government or as defined by any of the state laws of the U.S.

Out of all the current population of United States citizens over the age of 18 years old, 4-5% of them have broken the law against any type of child sex abuse as defined by the federal laws of the U.S. government or as defined by any of the state laws of the U.S.

Out of all the current population of United States citizens who are licensed to practice pediatric medicine through a state medical board:

7-8% of them have Pedophilic Disorder as defined by the diagnostic criteria of the DSM-5

5-6% of them have Sexual Sadism Disorder as defined by the diagnostic criteria of the DSM-5

4-5% of them have committed felony child sex abuse (any type of child sex abuse as defined by the federal laws of the U.S. government or as defined by any of the state laws) within the last five years

Out of all the current population of United States citizens who are licensed to practice OB-GYN medicine through a state medical board:

8-9% of them have Pedophilic Disorder as defined by the diagnostic criteria of the DSM-5

8-9% of them have Sexual Sadism Disorder as defined by the diagnostic criteria of the DSM-5

5-6% of them have committed felony child sex abuse (any type of child sex abuse as defined by the federal laws of the U.S. government or as defined by any of the state laws) within the last five years

Out of all the current population of United States citizens who are licensed to practice urology through a state medical board:

9-10% of them have Pedophilic Disorder as defined by the diagnostic criteria of the DSM-5

9-10% of them have Sexual Sadism Disorder as defined by the diagnostic criteria of the DSM-5

8-9% of them have committed felony child sex abuse (any type of child sex abuse as defined by the federal laws of the U.S. government or as defined by any of the state laws) within the last five years

Out of all the current population of United States citizens who are licensed to practice medicine through a state medical board and they are what we call general practice doctors:

12-13% of them have Pedophilic Disorder as defined by the diagnostic criteria of the DSM-5

13-14% of them have Sexual Sadism Disorder as defined by the diagnostic criteria of the DSM-5

11-12% of them have committed felony child sex abuse (any type of child sex abuse as defined by the federal laws of the U.S. government or as defined by any of the state laws) within the last five years

3-4% of them have committed felony child sex abuse (any type of child sex abuse as defined by the federal laws of the U.S. government or as defined by any of the state laws) within the last five years

Out of all the current population of United States citizens that are currently licensed to practice psychology through a state medical board, between .12- .13% of them are full-time employees of the FBI or NSA seeing clients in a public practice.

Out of all the current population of United States citizens that are currently licensed to practice psychiatry through a state medical board, between 1.5- 1.6% of them are full-time employees of the FBI or NSA seeing clients in public practice.
