

THE STEPHEN COLBERT SHOW: WHERE TRAFFICKERS GO TO GET GOOD P.R.

P.R. stands for public relations, and this is very important to people who participate in commercialized sexual violence for avoiding jail. Violent sex offenders rely on “No one will believe you because they will believe me instead,” to psych their victims out of filing police reports upon them.

Think about it for a minute. If you had Sexual Sadism Disorder as defined by the diagnostic criteria of the DSM-5, and you wanted to get away with sex crimes on adults or children the rest of your life, what would you do? If you are the charming type of pedophile, would you build a public persona and become really popular, get a lot of friends and “likes” on Facebook, and build a case that no one would ever believe your victims? Where would the safest place for you to be? Would it be out in the open, with millions of people believing in you as a wonderful charming person who would never do that?

During the year 2016, 100% of the guests who appeared onstage at the Stephen Colbert Show committed one or more felonies as defined by the federal laws of the U.S. government that fall within the category of sex crimes in the year 2016.

During the year 2016, 11-12% of the guests who appeared onstage at the Stephen Colbert Show committed one or more felonies as defined by the federal laws of the U.S. government that fall outside the category of sex crimes in the year 2016.

During the year 2007, 100% of the guests who appeared onstage at the Stephen Colbert Show committed one or more felonies as defined by the federal laws of the U.S. government that fall within the category of sex crimes in the year 2007.

During the year 2007, 11-12% of the guests who appeared onstage at the Stephen Colbert Show committed one or more felonies as defined by the federal laws of the U.S. government that fall outside the category of sex crimes in the year 2007.

Stephen Colbert has participated as a “customer” of human trafficking every year from 2008-2018.

During the year 2007, Stephen Colbert committed felony predatory sexual assault against a child as defined by NY Penal Code 130.96 eight times. He committed the crime of facilitating a sex offense with a controlled substance as defined by NY Penal Code 130.90 eight times. He committed the crime of course of sexual conduct against a child in the first degree as defined by NY Penal Code 130.75 eight times. Stephen Colbert committed the crime of possessing an obscene sexual performance by a child as defined by NY Penal Code 263.11 thirty-three times. In the year 2007, the oldest victim who was drugged with GHP by Stephen Colbert before he sexually assaulted them had been alive in a body on this planet for less than 10 years. Stephen Colbert did not participate as a “customer” of human trafficking in the year 2007.

During the year 2016, Stephen Colbert committed these felonies as defined by NY Penal Code:
facilitating a sex offense with a controlled substance (GHP) 107 times
course of sexual conduct against a child in the first degree 107 times
predatory sexual assault against a child 107 times
possessing an obscene sexual performance by a child 107 times

From 1/1/18 to 5/19/18, Stephen Colbert committed these felonies as defined by NY Penal Code:
facilitating a sex offense with a controlled substance (GHP) 37 times
course of sexual conduct against a child in the first degree 37 times
predatory sexual assault against a child 37 times
possessing an obscene sexual performance by a child 37 times

In the year of 2007, Stephen Colbert broke the law against the crime of terrorism as defined by NY Penal Code 490.25 eight times.

In the year of 2016, Stephen Colbert broke the law against the crime of terrorism as defined by NY Penal Code 490.25 one hundred and seven times.

In the year of 2018, Stephen Colbert broke the law against the crime of terrorism as defined by NY Penal Code 490.25 thirty-seven times.

During 2018 Stephen Colbert committed the crime of soliciting support for a terrorist act in the first degree as defined by NY Penal Code 490.15 three times; these crimes took place in February, March, and April.

In February, March, and April Stephen Colbert broke the law against making a terroristic threat as defined by NY Penal Code 490.20 at the premises of where his show is produced upon two different men who approached him at work to attempt to blackmail him. He also broke the law against intimidating a victim or a witness in the first degree as defined by NY Penal Code 215.17 upon these two men at the time he made the terroristic threat.
