

INTERNATIONAL HUMAN TRAFFICKING RING LED BY "423"

The man who has been nicknamed "423" is a serial rapist. He is the ringleader of a human trafficking ring, from 1996 to present.

"423" was born on June 21, 1975. He has had permanent residence in five countries in this lifetime.

"423" began his career as an international serial rapist at age 16, when he was recruited into a gang that raped and murdered. He committed his first murder in 1994. He began human trafficking in 1996. From 1996 to 2018, this man has kidnapped, raped, and sold hostages to be trafficked to serial rapists. For 22 years, his career has been the sales of hostages to survive rape camps until they were mass murdered.

International serial rapist "423" raped 98 people in Kyrgyzstan from 1996 to 1997, all females aged 16-34 years old. The hostages he sold were all women and children; his gang kept boys under the age 14 to send to the rape camps, and murdered all males age 14 and older. "423" sold 137 hostages to human traffickers in Kyrgyzstan during 1996-1997.

In 1998, he moved to Afghanistan, and had permanent residence there until 2002. From 2000-2002, "423" raped 136 people, all females aged 16-34 years old. He murdered 350 people, and sold more than 160 hostages to human traffickers in Afghanistan.

In 2003, "423" moved from Afghanistan to Japan. While "423" had permanent residence in Japan from 2003-2012, he sold more than 5,500 hostages to human traffickers while he was physically present in Japan. He did not arrange these business deals from a distance; he sold these hostages in person while he was in Japan.

In 2014, "423" moved to Afghanistan. During 2014 to 2015, "423" raped 96 people, and sold more than 170 hostages to human traffickers in Afghanistan.

In 2016, he moved to Iran. While he was in Iran from 2016 to March 17, 2018, "423" raped and trafficked more than 63 people.

International serial rapist "423" has participated in the murder of four CIA agents in 2003, 2009, 2016, and 2018; all four of these CIA agents were murdered as a result of switching sides to being against human trafficking. The FBI and CIA authorized the murder of these four CIA agents, who like all FBI and CIA agents were serial rapists, but unlike the rest, chose to resist international terrorism of human trafficking.

On March 4, 2016, a CIA agent was murdered by "423."

On March 15, 2018, a CIA agent was murdered by "423."

100% of international serial rapist "423's" customers of human trafficking from 1996 to 2018 were United States citizens; they are billionaires sick with pedophilia.

HOSTAGES SOLD TO UNITED STATES CITIZENS PARTICIPATING AS TRAFFICKERS:

Afghanistan 1998-2001 "423" sold 167 hostages to United States citizens

Japan 2001-2012 "423" sold 1,389 hostages to United States citizens

Kazakhstan 2012 "423" sold 18 hostages to United States citizens

Kyrgyzstan 2013 "423" sold 54 hostages to United States citizens

Iran 2016 to March 17, 2018 "423" sold 135 hostages to United States citizens

"423" began his business deal in 1996 with an elite group of U.S. citizens; a total of six people were selected to be his customers, and within that group of six, only three were allowed to purchase hostages for trafficking out of the rape camps.

From 1996 to 2018, international serial rapist "423" had a maximum of eight customers per year, which included three traffickers; all were United States citizens.

The three elite U.S. citizens who were the traffickers would purchase hostages directly from him, and keep their hostages at rape camps under his watch. The 3 traffickers would then sell the opportunity to rape their hostages to their own set of customers, which were an elite group of 22-23 people.

The elite group of 22-23 people who were the customers that visited the rape camps owned by the three elite United States citizens from 1996 to 2018 were billionaire citizens of England, France, Italy, Spain, Poland, Greece, Netherlands, Russia, and Japan.

The hostages who survived the rape camps were mass murdered by "423" and the traffickers who purchased them every couple of years. They were all killed with poison gas.

MASS MURDERS OF HOSTAGES WHO SURVIVED RAPE CAMPS:

22 hostages who survived rape camps were mass murdered on February 26, 1996 in Saudi Arabia

10 hostages who survived rape camps were mass murdered on January 17, 2001 in Afghanistan

44 hostages who survived rape camps were mass murdered on September 10, 2004 in Japan

46 hostages who survived rape camps were mass murdered on June 20, 2008 in Japan

38 hostages who survived rape camps were mass murdered on September 10, 2012 in Japan

23 hostages who survived rape camps were mass murdered on May 10, 2013 in Kyrgyzstan

36 hostages who survived rape camps were mass murdered on October 13, 2013 in Kyrgyzstan

44 hostages who survived rape camps in Afghanistan were mass murdered on June 20, 2016 in Iran

24 hostages who survived rape camps were mass murdered on January 17, 2017 in Iran

Until "423" is apprehended and prosecuted, hostages will continue to be kidnapped, raped, and sold into slavery; some will survive the rape camps and then be mass murdered.

On March 17, 2018, "423" moved back to Kyrgyzstan, which is the country of his current residence as of June 2, 2018.
