

CRIME LABS AND RAPE KITS

Crime labs in the U.S. are owned by state or federal government. 100% of the employees that have worked at crime labs in 2018 have committed felony rape as defined by any of the state laws of the U.S. with direct contact in 2018.

In 2018, the average amount of money paid as a bribe to any crime lab employee for committing the crime of falsifying medical records is \$12,000 per test.

There are 1,554 privately owned laboratories in the U.S. that perform lab work on blood & urine, DNA testing, and hair analysis testing for evidence of poisoning. 100% of privately owned laboratories have FBI, CIA, or NSA agents working at them. At each of these privately owned laboratories, 100% of their employees have committed felony rape as defined by any of the state laws of the U.S. with direct contact in 2018.

The average amount of money paid to any privately owned laboratory in the U.S. as a bribe for committing the crime of falsifying medical records is \$18,000 per test, and \$89,000 per bundle of lab-work.

When a person receives a rape kit exam, it is performed by a forensic nurse at a county hospital; the evidence collected from the rape kit exam is turned over to the police, who send it to a state-run crime lab.

100% of the forensic nurses who have performed rape kit exams at county hospitals in 2018 are FBI, CIA, or NSA agents. In 2018, the average amount of money paid as a bribe to a forensic nurse for committing the crime of falsifying medical records of a rape kit she performed is \$23,000 per rape kit.

91% of all rape kits that have been processed by a crime lab in the U.S. in 2018 were subject to state laws against the falsification of medical records being broken.
