THE PORTLAND HOTEL WITH THE HIGHEST RATE OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING IN 2018

The Fulton House Bed and Breakfast in the southwest quadrant of Portland, Oregon is the hotel with the most human trafficking taking place under its roof in the city of Portland. Three attorney generals own this hotel together and book the rooms exclusively for elite customers of human trafficking to be sheltered while they commit child sex abuse, rape, and make child pornography in a picturesque setting. Eric Schneiderman, now resigned as attorney general for the state of New York, owns the Fulton House Bed and Breakfast with AG Bill Schuette and AG Bob Ferguson.

Several weeks ago a human trafficker who works at OATH broke the laws against conspiracy to commit child sex abuse, rape, assault and battery, creation of child pornography, poisoning, and transporting victims of human trafficking with 23 other co-conspirators for crimes planned to take place on September 5 at the Fulton House Bed and Breakfast. On August 19 Bill Schuette booked every room at the Fulton House Bed and Breakfast for customers of human trafficking to stay for 7 nights beginning September 5th.

This felony conspiracy to commit crimes on September 5th was based on a plan for two human traffickers who work for OATH to transport 19 victims of human trafficking in a rented van to the Fulton House B&B around 8pm. The victims of human trafficking would be drugged with GHB ahead of time at a dose that allows them to walk while assisted.

These 19 people surviving human trafficking are ages 6 years old to 25 years old; they are citizens of Nigeria, Sudan, Zambia, Russia, Netherlands, and Poland. None of them speak English. They were all smuggled into Portland on the same date, August 18, 2015 through the Portland airport and have been held captive at the private residences of one human trafficker in leadership at OATH since then. This human trafficker owns four houses in Portland; three of his homes are used for keeping victims of human trafficking held hostage with one other trafficker (all employees of OATH) assigned to each home to watch over them and prevent them from leaving.
