

OREGONIANS AGAINST HUMAN TRAFFICKING (OATH)

OATH has 12 employees and 43 regular volunteers.

Of the OATH employees and volunteers, about 30% have been participating in human trafficking as customers, traffickers, or traders in the year 2018. These 17 criminals are stationed within OATH to sabotage OATH's excellent work fighting crime; they are comprised of 9 employees and 8 volunteers.

The 17 criminals include 9 employees who have been members of law enforcement for anywhere between 7 months and 5 years, and 8 volunteers who have worked for OATH anywhere from 6 months to 4 years.

17 OATH employees and volunteers have committed felony trafficking in persons as defined by ORS 163.266, and felony rape in the second degree as defined by ORS 163.365 multiple times during 2018.

This census was completed on September 26, 2018.
