

PEDOPHILIA WITHIN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH OF THE UNITED STATES

As of September 1, 2018, the Catholic Church of the U.S. had more than 2.6 million members of their clergy who currently have Pedophilic Disorder.

On September 1, 2018, the Catholic Church of the U.S. had 2,685,646 people who were members of their clergy.

On September 1, 2018, there were 18,368 people who were members of the clergy of the Catholic Church of the United States who were also FBI, CIA, or NSA agents in 2018.

Of the 2,685,646 people who were members of the clergy of the Catholic Church of the U.S. on September 1, 2018:

- 100% currently have Sexual Sadism Disorder
- 100% have committed rape as defined by the federal laws of the U.S. government in 2018
- 100% currently have Pedophilic Disorder
- The youngest victim of child sex abuse as defined by any of the state laws within the U.S. perpetrated by any member of the clergy of the Catholic Church of the U.S. in 2018 was a 2 month old baby
- The oldest victim of child sex abuse as defined by any of the state laws within the U.S. perpetrated by any member of the clergy of the Catholic Church of the U.S. in 2018 was 15 years old
- The oldest victim of felony rape in the first degree as defined by Oregon Revised Statutes perpetrated by any member of the clergy of the Catholic Church of the U.S. in 2018 was a person who was 94 years old
