

## SILICON VALLEY CRIME STOPPERS: PERCENTAGE OF DONORS WHO RAPE

The percentage of permanent paid employees of Silicon Valley Crime Stoppers that worked at Silicon Valley Crime Stoppers as their regular day job in August and September 2018 who committed one or more felonies in 2018 that fall within the category of sex crimes as defined by California state law is 88%.

The percentage of Silicon Valley Crime Stopper employees who committed felony rape as defined by California state law with direct contact in 2018 is 88%.

The percentage of permanent paid employees of Silicon Valley Crime Stoppers that worked at Silicon Valley Crime Stoppers as their regular day job in August and September 2018 who are FBI, CIA, or NSA agents in 2018 is 73%. All 73% of these employees have committed one or more felonies in 2018 that fall within the category of sex crimes as defined by California state law.

As of September 6, 2018, the percentage of financial contributions in the form of tax-deductible donations given to Silicon Valley Crime Stoppers in 2018 that came from individuals\* who committed felony rape as defined by California state law with direct contact in 2018 was 100%.

\*This includes donations from private businesses in which the individuals working for the business that initiated and followed through on the donations raped in 2018.

As of September 6, 2018, 81% of the financial contributions in the form of tax deductible donations given to Silicon Valley Crime Stoppers in 2018 were donated by people participating in human trafficking as customers, traders, or traffickers in 2018.

As of September 6, 2018, 76% of the financial contributions in the form of tax deductible donations given to Silicon Valley Crime Stoppers in 2018 were donated by people participating in human trafficking as traders or traffickers in 2018.
