Whole Foods has 8,613 store employees.

100% of the 8,613 employees who work at Whole Foods have committed felony rape as defined by any of the state laws within the United States with direct contact in 2018.

100% of the 8,613 employees who work at Whole Foods have participated in human trafficking as customers, traders, or traffickers in 2018.

57% of the 8,613 employees who work at Whole Foods are not United States citizens in 2018; they received employment with Whole Foods through identity theft, using ID's stolen from victims of human trafficking.

100% of the 8,613 employees who work at Whole Foods have traded food from the store where they work as payment to participate in human trafficking as a customer in 2018.

100% of the 8,613 employees who work at Whole Foods have committed felony child sex abuse as defined by any of the state laws within the United States with direct contact in 2018.

Out of all the police officers who have worked for any police department in the U.S. in 2018, more than 62% of them have not spent any money, not even one dime, on groceries in 2018.
