

SEXUAL BILL OF RIGHTS

Every human being has the right to enjoy their sexuality.

Every human being has the right to have safety and privacy over their genitals.

Every human being has the right to a free considerate, reciprocal sexual engagement with a voluntary partner.

Every human being has the right to be raised without tampering or mutilation to their sexual genitalia until they reach the age of consent and choose for themselves if and how they want their genitals interfaced with.

Every human being has the right to choose whether or not to share their sexuality with anyone else.

Every human being has the right to experience pleasure during the entire course of a sexual engagement, and their body sovereignty (choice of yes or no) respected.

Every human being has the right to have sex abuse prosecuted in the court of law without being blamed, shamed, or experiencing harassment.

Every human being has the right to safe sex education which instructs them on how to bring sexual pleasure to their partner.

The right to safe sex is not the entitlement to have a sex life.
