

## STATISTICS ON RAPE WITHIN INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING

### **NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF NATURAL MEDICINE**

NUNM currently has 212 employees.

In 2018, 92% of NUNM employees committed one or more felonies as defined by Oregon Revised Statutes that fall within the category of sex crimes within the last three years.

In 2018, 96% of NUNM employees were a victim of a sex crime as defined by Oregon Revised Statutes during the year 2018.

### **MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY**

Michigan State University currently has 533 employees. 91% of Michigan State University employees in 2018 were a victim or a perpetrator of a sex crime as defined by Michigan state law during the year 2018.

No punitive actions were taken upon the perpetrator.

#### **UNIVERSITY OF CENTRAL FLORIDA**

University of Central Florida currently has 546 employees. 93% of University of Central Florida employees in 2018 were a victim or a perpetrator of a sex crime as defined by Florida state law in the year 2018.

In the year 2016, there were 6 employees of University of Central Florida who had reported to the administration that they had been the victim of a sex crime as defined by Florida state law within the last three years in which the perpetrator of the crime was another employee of their institution. Two of the six were reporting the same violent sex offender to administration. Administration reviewed all their cases, and it did not result in any punishment to the perpetrator.

In the year 2018, there were 8 employees of University of Central Florida who had reported to administration that they had been the victim of a sex crime as defined by Florida state law within the last three years in which the perpetrator of the crime was another employee of their institution. Five out of the 8 reported the same perpetrator to administration in the year 2018, administration reviewed all their cases, and it resulted in no repercussions for the violent sex offender.

#### **UNIVERSITY OF OREGON**

University of Oregon currently has 543 employees. 98% of U of O employees in 2018 were a victim or perpetrator of a sex crime as defined by Oregon Revised Statutes within the last three years.

96% of U of O employees in 2018 were a victim or perpetrator of a sex crime as defined by Oregon Revised Statutes during the year 2018.

Nine U of O employees in 2016 were a victim of a sex crime as defined by Oregon Revised Statutes within the last three years in which the perpetrator of the crime was an employee of University of Oregon. All nine of these women had been drugged with GHB at the time the sex crime took place.

In the year 2016, six employees of the University of Oregon reported to the administration that they had been a victim of rape as defined by Oregon Revised Statutes within the last three years in which the perpetrator was an employee of U of O; all six reported the same perpetrator. The administration did nothing to review the cases. No punitive action was taken upon the violent sex offender.

In the year 2017, the same six employees of the University of Oregon reported again to the administration that they had been a victim of rape within the last three years in which the perpetrator was an employee of U of O; all six reported the same perpetrator. The administration did nothing to review the cases. No punitive action was taken upon the violent sex offender.

Nine U of O employees in 2018 were a victim of a sex crime as defined by Oregon Revised Statutes that took place during 2018 in which they had been drugged with GHB at the time the sex crime took place and the perpetrator of the crime was an employee of University of Oregon.

In 2018, the same six employees of the University of Oregon reported to the administration that they had been a victim of a sex crime as defined by Oregon Revised Statutes that took place during the year 2018 in which the perpetrator was an employee of U of O. The administration did nothing to review their cases and no punitive actions were taken against the violent sex offender, Dana Rognlie.

GHB can be put into food, beverages, or smokables and is almost completely undetectable. It is a common strategy of serial rapists to place a tiny dose of GHB into the intended victim's food, only enough to make the victim feel tired but not pass out, in order to get the victim used to the symptoms and not find anything unusual about those same symptoms when they are later hit with a big dose.

96% of University of Oregon employees in 2018 committed one or more felonies as defined by Oregon Revised Statutes that fall within the category of sex crimes during the year 2018.
