

NSA FAMILY

In 2017, the percentage of human trafficking in the United States that was perpetrated by a family member of the victim of human trafficking was 42%.

Of the people who survived human trafficking in the U.S. in 2017 perpetrated by a family member:

- 31% of the victims were adults
- 69% of the victims were persons under the age of 18 years old
- 3% of the victims were persons with developmental disabilities

Centers against domestic violence have institutionalized victim's denial of rape, referring to it as rough sex instead of acknowledging the crime of rape. The Domestic Abuse Intervention Program used the language "forced sex," and "hurtful sex," on the Power and Control Wheel diagram.

Although more than 97% of all cases of domestic violence that took place in the U.S. as defined by state laws included the crimes of rape in 2017, centers against domestic abuse frequently don't offer support with these types of cases and refer clients out to partnering agencies who specialize in rape.
