

## WORLD CENSUS ON HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Of the people world-wide who survived human trafficking in 2018:

- over 46% were male
- over 52% were female
- over 1.5% were transgender
- over 60% were under 18 years of age
- over 39% were adults
- more than 67% were citizens of the country they were surviving human trafficking in
- more than 32% were immigrants within 5 years of when they were very first trafficked

Of the people with permanent residence in the United States who survived human trafficking in 2018:

- over 30% were adults
- over 69% were under the age of 18 years of age
- over 46% were male
- over 52% were female
- over 1.3% were transgender
- more than 23% were immigrants within 5 years of when they were very first trafficked
- more than 76% were citizens of the U.S. when they survived human trafficking in 2018

The world population is about 7.7 billion people. Approximately 17% of the entire world population of human beings has survived human trafficking in the context of sexual violence for financial profit in 2019.

17% of 7.7 billion is 1,309,000,000, or 1.3 billion, 9 million people.

Of the approximated 1,309,000,000 human beings who have survived human trafficking in 2019:

- Over 71% currently have pedophilia
- Over 28% do not currently have pedophilia
- Between 71-72% have perpetrated human trafficking in 2019

Of the approximated 12.1% of the world population who have perpetrated slavery in the context of commercialized sexual violence:

- 87% have trafficked their spouse in 2019
- 100% of the people who have perpetrated human trafficking in the context of sexual violence for financial profit have trafficked a family member in 2019
- 62% have trafficked their biological children in 2019

- 62% have trafficked their niece or nephew in 2019
- 78% have trafficked a sibling of theirs in 2019
- 67% have trafficked a parent of theirs in 2019
- 65% have trafficked an aunt or uncle of theirs in 2019
- 54% have trafficked a grandparent of theirs in 2019
- 35% have trafficked a great-aunt or great-uncle of theirs in 2019
- 68% have trafficked their grandchildren in 2019
- 11% have trafficked their great-grandchildren in 2019

This census was conducted on February 24, 2019.
