

ABOMINABLE LIES ABOUT DATE RAPE DRUGS GHB, ROOFIES, AND KETAMINE

The prescription drugs Gamma-hydroxybutyric acid, Rohypnol, and Ketamine cannot be reasonably grouped in with alcohol in a discourse about date rape drugs. People willingly consume alcohol. No one willingly consumes animal tranquilizer or anesthesia while fully informed on the effects of these drugs. Serial rapists market ketamine (animal tranquilizer) as Special-K, and lie their faces off about what this drug does to the human body and how it will make you feel. Once a person has chosen to consume Special-K as a recreational drug, they do not ever make this mistake a second time; it is not the least bit addictive as some medical authorities have dug themselves a hole.

Gamma-hydroxybutyric acid (GHB) is a legal prescription drug in the United States. Rohypnol (roofies) is only legally prescribed in Europe and Latin America. Both GHB and Rohypnol have been historically used clinical anesthetic practice to prepare patients for surgery by inducing unconsciousness. No one would ever take GHB or roofies at a party or as a self-medicating drug in any location if they were aware of what they were consuming. Human traffickers with a Master's Degree in Doctor of Medicine have blatantly lied to the public about the symptoms of GHB/roofies poisoning, how it makes the victim feel, and what would ever make anyone want to take these drugs recreationally. Serial rapists love to promote the lie that the rape victim wanted it, he/she consented, and he/she was asking for it; they love to perpetrate confusion on people with secondary-trauma attempting to make sense of their senseless violence.

In a fake article <https://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/pubmed/26216563> about a non-existent medical study, the traffickers write, "Methods: Sixty recreational GHB users filled out a questionnaire on experienced subjective, somatic, and sexual effects of GHB, the frequency of blackouts due to their GHB use, and items on their sexual experiences in relation to GHB use." The only recreational GHB users out there are serial rapists who use GHB to poison their victims unconscious.

It does not take a person with any mortician training to distinguish that there is no such thing as a person who is unconscious feeling extra affectionate. The following false statements have been used on <https://www.healthlinkbc.ca/health-topics/uq2448> to advertise to the public that the people responsible for publishing these lies are trafficking. It is a way of attracting serial rapist customers. GHB was never sold in health food stores; it is a

controlled prescription drug. GHB makes a person feel like crap no matter what the dose. The effects of GHB are the exact opposite as what they describe here. “Until 1992, GHB was sold in health food stores in products to build muscle tissue and to reduce body fat. Today, it can be obtained over the Internet and often is available at all-night dances, raves, and nightclubs. At low doses, the drug relaxes the person. The person feels intoxicated, has more energy, feels happy, and is talkative. Other effects include: Feeling affectionate and playful. Mild loss of inhibition. Increased sensuality. Enhanced sexual feelings.”

“The resulting loss of inhibition, impaired judgement, and memory loss are reasons why these drugs are used in rape.” The traffickers said this to trick the public into believing that their customers prefer their victims to be conscious. All the customers of human trafficking share the desire to rape a person who is either dying or feels dead. In this medically reviewed article on <https://www.healthline.com/health/date-rape-drugs#symptoms> the traffickers advertise their business to customers with statements like these: “A tiny amount of GHB can have a major effect, [causing the symptom increased sensuality.]” These exact same false statements from medical authorities abusing the trust of the public are repeated on the University of Michigan website <https://www.uofmhealth.org/health-library/uq2448> Incidentally, Michigan ranks 4th highest out of the 50 states for crimes of human trafficking.

Can these traffickers on WebMD <https://www.webmd.com/mental-health/addiction/date-rape-drugs> shout any louder to people in the know, *Hey! Over here! We are trafficking high schoolers!* “High school kids are using this as an alternative to alcohol. It leaves no odor for parents to detect, and the effects may be gone by the time users return home from a night out.” Who would be providing GHB to high schoolers anyway? Traffickers selling virgins to be raped to customers who prefer to fulfil their fantasy of raping a dead virgin.

Apparently, by acting quickly once you realize you have been poisoned with animal tranquilizer or anesthesia, you can overcome the purported symptom of impaired judgement and rescue yourself! If you call 9-1-1 and ask for help getting to the hospital, they will dispatch police from the Behavioral Health Unit to evaluate whether or not you need to be disciplined. If you manage to get to the Emergency Room at the nearest hospital and ask to be treated for poisoning, the ER doctor will explain to you that their hospital does not test for GHB. A test for GHB is only available in the context of a rape kit exam or in the context

of pressuring your primary care physician for lab orders with a 90 day expiration. The traffickers will have to spend money on bribing the lab techs, and they try to magnify their profits.
